Dear Parents/Guardians of High School Juniors and Seniors:

The start of the 2018-2019 school year is rapidly approaching. Student parking will be located along the sides and front of the school. Additional parking will be available in "The PIT". Student drivers will receive a parking tag for their vehicle, which must be displayed on the rearview mirror at all times while on campus.

Student driving privileges are extended to junior and senior drivers. The cost of the driving permit will be (\$200.00) for parking around the school and (150.00) for parking in "The PIT", PAYMENT IS DUE ON DATE OF PICK UP. Student parking passes may be obtained at the Welcome Center in the high school building on:

Seniors only

August 7, 2018

8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Juniors and Seniors

August 8, 2018

8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

The following conditions must be adhered to in order for students to be considered for a parking passes:

- 1. Students may only park in the designated Student Parking Areas.
- All student parking spaces are numbered. The space number corresponds to the number on the parking tag.
- Students' vehicles must remain in their designated lot until they exit school. 3.
- 4. All parking spaces are **HEAD IN PARKING ONLY**.
- Traffic may only flow in one direction around the campus for the safety of all. Please observe all 5. directional signs carefully. When leaving the "PIT" traffic will exit around the back of the building.
- Students must have a valid Pennsylvania driver's license at the time of registration to obtain a parking 6. permit. Parking passes will not be reserved for those with learners' permits or those who have not yet passed the test.
- Students may not "swap" parking permits. All students must obtain their own parking pass. 7.
- All student driving regulations on the parking permit application form and in the Student-Parent 8. Handbook must be followed. Failure to do so will result in revocation of the parking privilege. Permit fees are not refundable for any reason.
- A complete listing of regulations for student drivers is included in the Student-Parent Handbook. Please 9. review them carefully with your child.
- 10. Students will be expected to only enter in the morning through the front doors by the Welcome Center. Early release students must sign out and exit through Welcome Center.
- Student drivers will remain in the auditorium at the end of the school day until buses have exited 11. the campus.

Enclosed is an application for a parking permit. Please return the completed application with both parent and student signatures to the Main Office. Each student will need to provide a copy of his/her current license, updated insurance information and updated vehicle registration to be considered for a parking permit. Please be sure that your child has all required documentation at the time of registration, as spaces cannot be reserved for those who do not have all the documentation in hand at one time.
