- **Sandra Clutter discussed that Mr. Lenzer (G.G. & C) attended the December 2010 meeting to discuss the Amwell Township bus run with - which is only one-half of a run and the district is paying full cost of \$267.50 per day.**

- Mrs. VanVarenburg stated the districts receives 80% of the monies back from the state – this information was found on the PDE website by Mrs. Dye
- Sandra Clutter, Henry Clemens and Levi Bristor distributed options for changing the bus run on mainly Shipe and Potato Run Road
- Parents in attendance spoke on the issue of their children losing sleep and the length of time their child will be on the bus
- The parents asked if this would be effective with the next school year – they were told this would be effective ASAP
- Sandra Clutter informed everyone that letters from the building principal would be sent out to parents that would have their child affected by this change
- In regards to the options that were distributed - the four parents in attendance advised the board members also in attendance that they could live with Option #3 or Option #6 – preferably option #6
- The four parents in attendance suggested Trinity look into asking Lenzer to provide them a smaller bus
- Mrs. Clutter informed everyone the cost is the same
- Mrs. Clutter advised the parents they will consider their option
