The meeting was called to order at 10:05 a.m. by Sandy Clutter

Public Comment

Representatives of the Hite Company reported on replacement of lighting in the elementary and middle schools and discussed a rebate available through Allegheny Power.

Mr. Kuzman reported that the swipe card system was in place. Dr. Kasunich indicated that he would address how much access employees would be given to the buildings at the next administrative meeting and that a list would be created.

Mrs. Clutter noted that the stop sign at the high school needed to be made permanent. Mr. Kuzman will take steps to complete the project. Discussion was held regarding Mr. Stoehr's role in issuing citations.

It was the consensus of the Committee that Bus 12 should be eliminated as it is not a full run. Mr. Lenzner indicated that the district had the option to eliminate buses.

Traffic at the high school was discussed. Mr. Bristor indicated that parents on campus early at dismissal time are a problem. Student parking at the middle school was also discussed.

Discussion was held regarding relocating the crossing guard from Trinity West to the Middle School at dismissal to redirect cars and then reporting to Trinity West to finish his duties.

Dr. Kasunich and Mr. Artuso suggested an amendment to the transportation contract with Mr. Lenzner to alleviate the district paying for transportation errors.

The possible redistricting and/or reconfiguration of the elementary schools was discussed.

New business

Mr. Clemens discussed a safety program at the elementary schools.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:55 a.m.
