The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Henry Clemens, Chairman.

Public Comment

Discussion was held concerning a meeting with Range Resources which was held September 28, 2010 regarding gas well drilling scheduled to begin on Middle School property. Mr. Clemens noted that a crisis plan in the event of an emergency needed to be developed between the school district, the township and Range Resources. Discussion was held concerning traffic, a buffer zone and emergency access road between the tennis courts and Arnold Road. It was determined that a meeting between all interested parties would be scheduled by Mr. Kuzman to develop an emergency evacuation plan.

Times of buses arrivals

Mrs. Clutter discussed buses at the middle school arriving too early and asked Mr. Bristol to investigate how to alleviate the problem.

Number of inefficient bus runs

Mr. McWreath discussed the possibility of requesting parents to sign a waiver for students who do not utilize bus transportation in order that the student may be removed from bus rosters. Mr. Bristol will explore this option.

Guard for Middle school

Mr. Bristol indicated that he and Mr. Stoehr were reviewing the crossing guards at all of the buildings and will make necessary adjustments.

Misuse of Visitor Parking

Mr. McWreath discussed the possible misuse of Visitor Parking at the high school. Mr. Stoehr will investigate.

New business

Mr. McWreath noted an item on the September 30th Board agenda dealing with a stop sign at the merge point at the high school indicating that the item should be voted on at that meeting.

Mr. Kuzman reported that the cost of installing a card swipe system for access to Trinity Hall would be \$5, 415.
